DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

Why do some relationships last a lifetime, and others only a matter of months or just a few years? Often there is a specific reason-- he wants a baby, she doesn't; he puts his career first, she last; he likes broccoli, she likes asparagus. But what of those unexplainable breakups? --the ones that fall apart in spite of perfect compatibility?

Julie and Luke is one such couple, and Luke is stunned to learn relationships don't always succeed when running on 'automatic' --some require work. The result for Luke is the memory of the perfect mate, now gone.

My aim was to tell this story without judgment or condescension, and absent of *Hollywood* heartstrings.

CAST and CREW

Anthony Jannelli (Director)

Anthony Jannelli is a cinematographer and is currently Head of Studies at New York University, Tisch School of the Arts, Graduate Film & Television. A partial list of feature film credits include *Philadelphia*, *Silence of the Lambs*, and *Something Wild* with director Jonathan Demme, *New York Stories* with Martin Scorsese, and *Billy Bathgate* with Robert Benton, as well as *Independence Day*, *Ghostbusters II*, *Three Men and a Baby*, and *Big*, and many others.

His first feature as a director of photography, *Longtime Companion*, won the 1991 Audience Award at the Sundance Film Festival.

He shot additional photography for the Neil Young concert film *Heart of Gold*, and for Martin Scorsese's upcoming documentary on the Rolling Stones, *Shine A Light*. He photographed the pilot and entire first season of *Law and Order: Special Victims Unit*, and he currently shoots east coast location scenes for the Bruckheimer television series *Without A Trace*, *Cold Case*, and *CSI NY*.

Tony has filmed music videos featuring Michael Jackson, Paul McCartney, The Rolling Stones, Talking Heads, Bruce Springsteen and Laurie Anderson, as well as hundreds of television commercials.

A Member of the International Cinematographers Guild and the Directors Guild of America, he has been an instructor at the Sundance Filmmakers Workshop and the Maine Photographic Workshops for Film and Television.

A professor in cinematography at NYU Graduate Film & Television, Tony became Head of the Cinematography Department in 2005, and was named Head of Graduate Studies in 2007. In 2007, he directed the short film *Five Years of Forever*.

Justin Golding (Luke/Executive Producer/ Writer/)

Justin Golding has directed two feature films, *God's Forgotten House*, www.wonderphil.biz (Int. rights), www.hannoverhouse.com (USA rights), which he also wrote and *The Gods of Circumstance* www.cineville.com (World rights). He has also written and directed a documentary on the Bahai Faith called *Mirrors of God* and two TV pilots called *Discount British Comedy* and *The Newsroom*, www.goldrushproductions.biz. Two short film scripts of his have been produced and he has directed three short films. A number of his plays have been produced and Justin is

also a published author of poetry and short stories. At present, he has film projects at different levels of development and is in the middle of a Ph.D. in creative and critical writing at the University of Wales, Aberystwyth. To date, Justin has won two Accolade awards for directing and for his feature film *God's Forgotten House*.

Jason Sokoloff (JSOK) (Producer)

Jason Sokoloff, is a native New Yorker who grew up against the gritty urban backdrop of Brooklyn/Queens in the 1970's and 80's. A one time graffiti artist, successful art director and seasoned veteran of the city's infamously tough stand-up comedy circuit, Jason draws the core of his inspiration from a rich childhood, spent between the city's best museums and it's most seedy racetracks. Jason has over ten years of experience in the entertainment industry, with an emphasis on art direction, production, and marketing. He has produced advertisements and other collateral materials tailored to clients in the publishing, music, film, and advertising industries. His production credits include over 200 live comedy shows. His monthly comedic storytelling show, "Urban Myth", co-produced with DC Benny, has received extensive press coverage and attracts great talent to the stage that includes Jim Norton, Dave Chapelle and Jim Gaffigan. Jason was also the producer and co-director of a short comedy pilot that was featured in the Montreal Comedy Festival and his short film "Treasure of Riverside Park" was recently featured at Lincoln Center and has currently been played at 14 festivals in the states and abroad. Most recently Jason was the line producer on the feature film "Heterosexuals". As a strong proponent of independent filmmaking and comedy, Jason's spirit carries many. He is currently working on several short films, and feature scripts while pursuing his M.F.A. at New York University's graduate film program.

Charlotte af Geijerstam (Julie)

Charlotte af Geijerstam, was born and raised in Sweden, and in her modeling career she has been seen on billboards throughout Europe. Upon being accepted to the advanced study program at the Lee Strasberg theatre institute, she moved to New York City and has since studied with renowned acting technique teachers Harold Guskin and Austin Pendelton.

After appearing in national commercials for *Peroni Beer* and TV series appearances on *CSI NY*, she is now being seen in the New York independent film scene, appearing in principal roles in three films now circulating the festival circuit in the US and Europe.

She recently starred as the love interest in the independent hit *Let Them Chirp Awhile* opposite actors Justin Rice, Anthony Rapp, Zach Galligan, Brendan Sexton and Laura Breckenridge. This film had its premiere on opening night at the '07 Woodstock Film Festival to great acclaim, later winning the East Lansing Film Festival in 2008. *Let Them Chirp Awhile* will have a nationwide release in September 2008.

Charlotte can also be seen at the Stockholm Film Festival in her leading role in *Scene # 1*, the latest film by award winning Swedish director Jon Rekdal.

Most recently Charlotte is starring in Anthony Jannelli's short film *Five Years of Forever*, portraying *Julie* in this heartbreakingly beautiful film about the fragility of human relationships.
